Note :

- 22 of 41 graduates (54%) have found employment. You must bear in mind that in most professions, graduates are expected to work in unpaid internships for two years before being eligible for a salary. One of the 41 is deceased (Clarisse) ; if she is not counted in the total, it is 22 of 40 graduates, or 55%.
- Of the 28 who finished their studies before 2019, 19 are employed (68%). Without counting Clarisse, it's 19 out of 27 or 70%.
- Of the 22 who finished their studies before 2018, 17 have found employment (77%). Not counting Clarisse = 81%.
- Of the 15 who finished their studies before 2017, 12 have found a job (80%). Not counting Clarisse = 86%.
