BWEF President Fred Eckhard has known Noëlie Zongo since 2009, when he first visited Burkina Faso. She was at that time Treasurer of our sister association, *Solidarité Goëlo-Burkina*. After two years of negotiations with the 1% Fund, led by Nicole Hochschild in Geneva, we obtained the grant to help Noëlie improve the infrastructure of her dressmaking school for high school dropouts, CEMEF in Koudougou.
